## Invitation:

Enclosed is an application for participation in the “Lake Redman Festival”, to be held on Saturday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> from 12:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Formally called “Spring Happening”, the event has delighted people of all ages for more than twenty years. If you have never participated, we welcome you to a beautiful site along the shores of Lake Redman in Southern York County. It is easy to get to by exits 10 and 14 of Interstate 83. The boat dock area and pavilions offer a beautiful view of the lake and there is plenty of parking for the public. Electricity is available in the pavilions. There will be music, dances, activities and decorations to fit the theme, Island Fest. The proceeds from this event benefit the Lake Redman Summer Concert Series offered free to the public during the last four Sunday evenings of summer.

## Rules and Procedures:

- Only work made by the applicant is acceptable. Artisans whose work is selected must be in attendance at the festival.
- Please send one or two colored pictures, illustrations or brochures of your craft. Pictures will be returned the day of the event unless you allow the committee to keep one on file for future use.
- The artisan must provide tables and chairs.
- If you would like to donate a door prize for the event, we will list your name in the program. Please indicate on your application if you wish to donate. Items should be brought to the Information Booth by 11:00 AM.
- Artisans will park at a designated lot on the site. Most artisans’ cars can remain at their stands. Handicapped parking is available. Park Rangers and Committee personnel will aid in the parking.
- Set-up time is from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM the day of the event. The festival runs from 12:00 PM until 7:00 PM. NO ONE will be admitted before 9:30 AM!
- Artisans must leave the park by 9:00 PM. You are responsible for the removal of all trash generated at your stand. Receptacles are available throughout the park. Please leave your area free of litter and in the same condition as you found it.
- There is NO RAIN DATE.

**Directions to William Kain Park:**

From the North: Follow I 83 south to the exit at Leader Heights. Yield right onto Leader Heights Road. At the second traffic light, turn left onto S. George Street. Continue on this road to Jacobus. Turn left onto Church Street at Olp's Flower Shop. Continue to the Park entrance on your left.

From the South: Follow I 83 north to the Loganville exit. Turn left onto Lake Road and go 2 miles to the stop sign. Turn left onto Church Street (Hess Farm Road) and go a short distance to the Park entrance on your right.
