John Rudy County Park

Brick pavers around grills – materials provided.

Rocky Ridge County Park

- Close "unofficial trails"
- Assist with replanting timbered areas
- Trail Trimming - Trim back plant growth along the trails – Trails #7 and #4 are two trails we need help trimming through the summer and fall of each year. We will provide gloves and loppers.

William H. Kain County Park

- One canopy table at Iron Stone Hill Rd – parking lot

- Trail Trimming –Trim back plant growth along the trails – Trails #5, 5A, 7 & 2B are trails we need help trimming through the summer and fall of each year. We will provide gloves and loppers.

Richard M. Nixon County Park

- Sensory Garden - remove invasive plants/add plantings –
- Adopt a Garden – Available in Rocky Ridge, Spring Valley, Kain, Rudy, and Nixon County Parks. Located at park entrances and within several of the parks. We ask that a flower garden be mulched, weeded and planted in the spring. Continue to maintain the garden throughout the summer. We provide gloves, mulch (delivered to site), shovels, pitchforks...all tools needed to maintain the site.

Spring Valley County Park

- Reroute trail #5
- 2 canopy tables at Animal Activity Area – Materials provided
- Trail Trimming - trim back plant growth along the trails – Trails #1, 2 and 5 are three trails we need help trimming through the summer and fall of each year. We will provide gloves and loppers.
- 1 canopy table at fish for fun parking lot – Materials provided
- Stream Litter Clean Up - After trout season, lots of trash can be found along the East Branch as it flows through the park. We provide bags and gloves...scouts can leave the bags along the road for pickup by our maintenance department.
- Road Clean Up in Spring Valley County Park – We provide bags and gloves...scouts can leave the bags along the road for pickup by our maintenance department.
