- The ratio of chaperones to scouts must meet the minimum requirements of your scouting organization.
- No food or beverages will be provided. Please bring refillable water bottles or beverages of your choice, and all the supplies you will need for your picnic lunch including trash bags or wash buckets to carry dirty dishes home. Trash is carry in/ carry out. We also recommend you bring tarps or blankets for sitting outside. There are no picnic tables and no indoor seating unless it's raining.
- Payment must be paid in full within two weeks of registering to hold your group's spot. If your payment is not received, you will be moved to the waiting list.
- Fees will only be refunded if the York County Parks must cancel the event.
- Please prepare for the weather. Most activities will be outdoors including lunch. Lunch can be moved inside in the case of rain; however, hikes will go on in light rain.
- Scouts and chaperones are invited to shop in our new gift shop before or after the program, and/or during your scavenger hunt.
- Registration begins January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012.
